

Exam in Neurology – Information

The venue of the exam in neurology is the Department of Neurology, 5th floor, entrance F or D. Prerequisites for the exam is the completion of both practicals and credit in winter semester. The exam has two parts, the written one (the test) and the oral one consisting of two questions all in one day. You will begin with the written test, which contains 35 questions. The time limit is 35 minutes. There is only one correct answer for each question. You will receive the form with questions and preprinted answers (capital letters A, B, C, D, E) for each question. You should mark clearly the correct answer with circle or cross the capital letter. Keep the answers unequivocal and legible, please. In order to successfully pass the written test you need to answer correctly at least 24 out of 35 questions/points (32 to 35 points = 1, 29 to 31 points = 2, 24 to 28 points = 3, 23 and less points = 4). Then you will continue with the oral part of exam. During the oral part you will answer one question from general neurology and one from special neurology. You will have 20 minutes for preparation and then at least 20 minutes for answering both question and discussion. For the completion of the exam you need to successfully pass both the written and oral part (it means sufficient knowledge of both questions). If you fail at the oral part and you will have to repeat the exam (at the other date), you will not need to do the written part again, in case you have achieved 24 to 35 points. There is one exception for the 3rd term of the exam – even if you fail the written part, you can continue to the oral part. There is an examination board for the 3rd terms consisting.
